

# The American Society of Neuroradiology Cornelius G. Dyke Memorial Award

#### **History & Eligibility**

This award was established to honor Cornelius G. Dyke, one of the pioneers in Neuroradiology, and is given to an **assistant professor**, **fellow or resident** for excellence as demonstrated in a paper, which represents original, unpublished research in some aspect of Neuroradiology.

In addition to a new paper submitted for the Annual Meeting, the Cornelius G. Dyke Memorial Award is open to manuscripts submitted to the *American Journal of Neuroradiology (AJNR)* and/or published since January 1, 2016. Authors of *AJNR* manuscripts must submit an abstract (no manuscript at this time).

Following review of abstracts, authors of the highest-ranking abstracts will be asked to submit a manuscript and a signed certification statement. Abstracts to be considered for the award must be received by 5:00pm Pacific Standard Time (PST), Friday, December 9, 2016.

### The Dyke Award includes:

- ★ A \$2,500 honorarium
- ★ Invitation to present the work at the 55<sup>th</sup> Annual Meeting in 2017
- ★ Complimentary registration for the 55<sup>th</sup> Annual Meeting in 2017
- \* Round-trip coach travel to Long Beach, California, two night's lodging and meals
- ★ Announcement in the American Journal of Neuroradiology (AJNR) and posting on the ASNR web site

## **Application Deadline:**

To be considered for the award, submit an abstract electronically to the ASNR office by **5:00pm Pacific Standard Time (PST), Friday, December 9, 2016.** This award is open to manuscripts submitted to the *AJNR* and/or published since January 1, 2016.
